Study Island Directions

Please refer to the "Unit 7 - Self Study Plan" handout to see the focus areas that need to be practiced throughout the summer. We have posted a list of the third grade assignments in Study Island that relate to each focus area on our Weebly pages. Students should work on mastering these areas first (at least an 88%) before moving on to other skills. Students who have mastered all third grade skills and completed their NWEA My Learning Path should practice fourth or fifth grade skills.

There will be no individual or class assignments posted on Study Island. Since unit 7 is self-directed, students will all be working at their own pace. All log-on information will be the same. Once students have logged on, they will complete the following steps:

- 1. Click on the (+) next to MI Programs on the left side of the screen.
- 2. Click on the correct grade level. For most students this will be 3rd grade.
- 3. Students can choose from "Math" or "Common Core Math."
- 4. In order to choose from the assignments, students must take the Pre-Test. After they have completed all these problems, they may choose from the list of assignments. Make sure to refer to the file that suggests assignments relating to the focus areas!
- 5. Assignments do not have to be completed in a particular order. In order to have accurate results, students should be answering a minimum of 20 questions per assignment.
